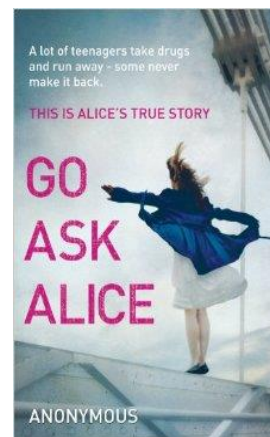


Go ask Alice – a literature and reflective writing project w. 3- 11

What?

You will be listening to/reading the teen novel *Go Ask Alice* by Anonymous for the next couple of weeks. The project will focus on your understanding of an English literature book related to your own reflections on teen issues. You will be answering questions about the content of the book, writing your own diary journal while reading and also participate in oral discussions based on the diary journal. **The answering of questions, your diary journal and the oral discussions will be the object for assessment along with a book review you will be asked to write at the end of this project.**



Why?

I det centrala innehållet för årskurs 7-9 står det att undervisningen i engelska ska innehålla aktuella och för eleverna bekanta ämnesområden, där elevernas intressen, åsikter och erfarenheter och känslor skall kunna uttryckas. Relationer och etiska frågor är också något som undervisningen i engelska skall beröra.

Vi arbetar mot kunskapskraven som handlar om ”att förstå innehåll och detaljer i talad engelska och olika texter. Eleven förväntas kunna visa sin förståelse genom att redogöra för och kommentera innehållet samt agera utifrån budskap och instruktioner i innehållet. Eleven kan även använda sig av strategier för lyssnande och läsning.”

How?

Weekly based tasks. Read approximately 30 pages per week. Complete the questions checking your understanding and write in your dairy journal after each reading. Prepare for oral discussion.

Friday 20th of January

Introduction – your teacher will start reading the book. You will write in your diary journal and then share your thoughts orally. **Homework for Friday the 27th of January : read until p. 30.**

W. 4

Friday 27th of January

We will do the checking of understanding together (part 1) + individual journal writing. We will look at the book talk questions together. **Homework for Friday the 3rd of February: Read until p. 60.**

W. 5

Friday the 3rd of February

Checking of understanding (part 2) + and journal writing. **Homework for Friday the 10th of February: Read until p. 90.**

W. 6

Friday the 10th of February

Work with your checking of understanding questions and the journal writing. Book talk. **Homework for Friday the 17th of February: read until p.120.**

W. 7

Friday the 17th of February

Work with your checking of understanding questions and the journal writing. **Homework for Friday the 24th of February: Finish the book (until p. 158).**

W. 8

Friday the 24th of February

Book talk. Checking of Understanding. We will read the epilogue and “What defeated Alice”. **Homework for Friday the 10th of March: Prepare for the last checking of Understanding questions + Plan your book review writing.**

Work on your **book review and hand in on Friday the 17th at the latest.**
