Answer the students' questions about Dian Fossey on Stolofsara. (Individual work in your Svenska map). Practise describing the words from the wordlist to each other.

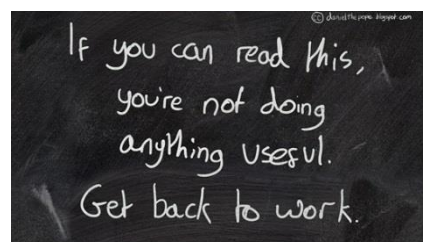
Lesson 8, 9 & 10 (Monday and Thursday) w. 21 + (Monday w. 22)

How to work with your text

1. Read the text out loud (take turns).
2. Make a list of difficult words and translate them into Swedish. (In a document in your Swedish folder titled with your text)



3. Divide the text in two parts and create a few questions on your part. Don't forget to write down the answers (the key) in a separate document. When you are done try to summarize the text in English and discuss it based on the theme "How to make a change"(orally).

4. If you have got time, practice describing the words to each other (orally).
